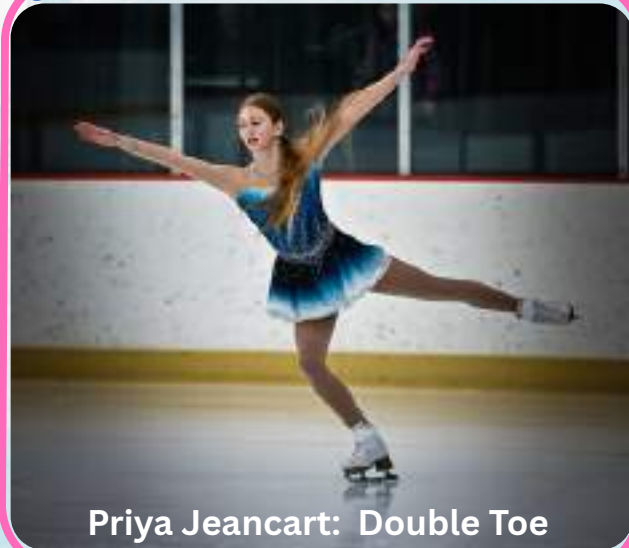

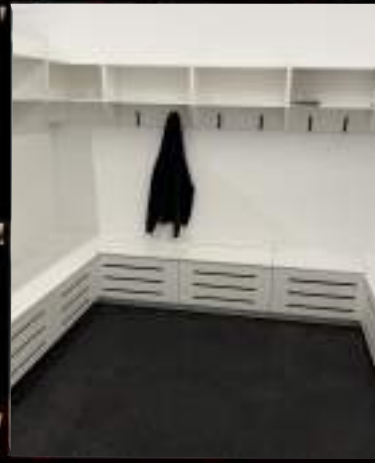

Our athletes wore their green with pride and truly made the most of the experience—even with an intense snowstorm cutting things a little short!



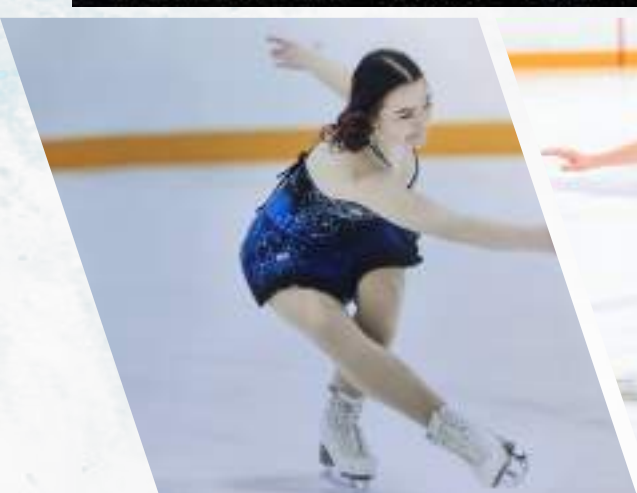
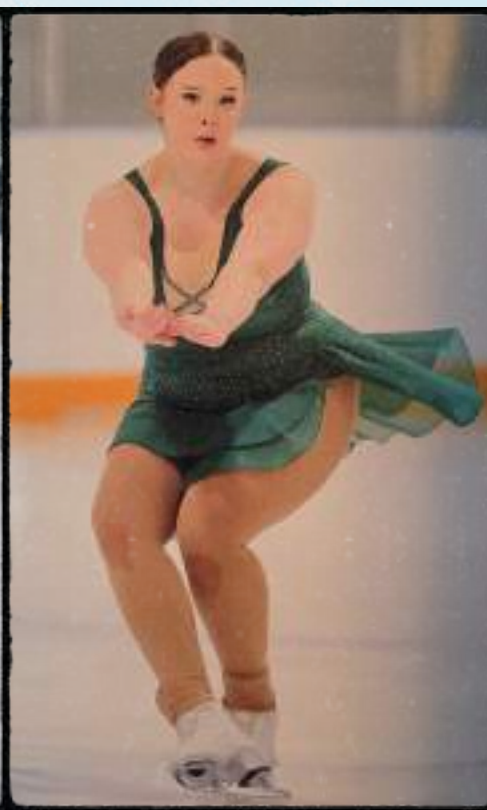
Winter Classic: Swift Current
